- Provide special accommodations for testing
- Open tutoring:
 - A time when a tutor for a specific subject or course will work with any ACNHS student who attends
 - Stay for as little or as long as you need
 - Pre-scheduling or applying is not necessary to attend open tutoring sessions
 - Days and times may vary from term to term so check schedule for availability

What You Can Do

- Attend class regularly and sit in the front row.
- Listen attentively in class, take notes, ask questions, and copy everything the instructor writes on the board.
- Attempt your homework independently before tutoring session and identify problem areas.
- Use tutors to clarify and/or reinforce confusing concepts or topics from the classroom
- Use tutors to find resources such as websites, models, journals, and other study aids.
- Use tutors to review work that has already been graded.
- Start early! Don't wait until you are falling behind or failing!
- **Bring a positive attitude!**
