The purpose of this scholarship is to provide support to students who demonstrate significant academic potential and to support Aultman's goal of promoting a diverse student body, which is key to its educational mission. Each applicant's qualifications will be considered on an individual basis. As part of this process, Aultman will give consideration to the applicant's socioeconomic group, educational background and/or status as a member of an underrepresented group, so long as this consideration is in keeping with the goal of obtaining the educational benefits of diversity.

General Information

The Aultman Minority Inclusion Scholarship Fund will award the scholarship recipient \$2,500 payable to Aultman College for the academic year.

The scholarship recipient is eligible to reapply annually for a maximum amount of \$5,000 for an associate degree and \$10,000 for a bachelor's degree.

The scholarship will be sent to Aultman College after successful completion of the semester.

The scholarship recipient may be considered for employment at Aultman Health Foundation based on completion of the program in its entirety and job availability.

The committee will not consider any application that is incomplete and/or not received by the deadline of September 15, 2020.

All information supplied by the applicant is strictly confidential.

General Criteria:

- ✚ Must be a member of an American ethnic minority group.
- ✚ Must express financial need.
- ✚ Must be a U.S citizen.
- ✚ Must be a traditional or non-traditional student residing in Carroll, Holmes, Portage, Stark, Summit, Tuscarawas or Wayne county.
- ✚ Must have a minimum entrance GPA of 3.0.
- ✚ Must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit hours.
 - Scholarship renewal may be awarded if the following criteria is met:
 - Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or greater.
 - Demonstrate annual commitment of 40 total hours during academic breaks to include:
 - Community service
 - Volunteering
 - Unpaid internship
 - Shadow an assigned Aultman employee mentor in the career area of study

****Failure to meet the commitment hours could result in scholarship forfeit.*
