The following scholarships are available for this academic year (fall and spring). These awards will be annual awards which means, **apply once and get the award for both fall and spring semester!**

Please submit:

1. One essay
  - Be sure to read the criteria of each. If the scholarship asks for a specific interest, be sure to mention it
  - Essays typical include community involvement, financial burdens, school engagement, and how this scholarship will assist you in achieving your educational goals.
2. One biography
  - This allows the scholarship committee to get to know you. Typical biographies include your name, your employment, and what drives you to succeed.

**1892 Endowed Scholarship – \$1000 (\$2000 annual)**

- Must have a minimum high school or college GPA (whichever is most recent) of 2.5 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA
- Recipients must complete 1 hour of a designated community service requirement per \$500 award

**1892 Gifted Scholarship – \$1000 (\$2000 annual)**

- Must have a minimum high school or college GPA (whichever is most recent) of 2.5 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA
- Recipients must complete 1 hour of a designated community service requirement per \$500 award

**Ann and Tom Kinney BSN Scholarship - \$1500 (\$3000 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College BSN student
- Must be at minimum a sophomore-level student
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA
- Preference is given to student whose GPA places them in top 20% of class

**Aultman Hospital Endowed Scholarship Fund – \$750 (\$1500 annual)**

- Must have a minimum Aultman College GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must be a United States Citizen
- Must be a resident of Stark County
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA
- Preference will be given to minority students

**Bettie Sponseller Memorial Endowed Scholarship\* – \$875 (\$1750 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

**Charity School of Kendal Gifted Scholarship – \$2500 (\$5000 annual)**

- Must be in good academic standing
- Must be 24 years of age or less
- Must be a resident of Stark County
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

**Ella Mae Kuecher Memorial Endowed Scholarship\* – \$1000 (\$2000 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student
- Must have a minimum high school or college GPA (whichever is most recent) of 3.0 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Recipient must be in the top 1/3 of his or her high school graduating class
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

**Estate of Kathleen L. Greer Endowed Scholarship\* – \$625 (\$1250 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student
- Must have a minimum high school or college GPA (whichever is most recent) of 2.5 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater

- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

- Must be at minimum a sophomore-level student
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must be a non-traditional student
- Must be a resident of Summit County

**Mary Roden Memorial Endowed Scholarship\* – \$2500 (\$5000 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate (in writing) a desire and potential for a career in nursing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

**Roslyn E. Messerly Lifetime Achievement Memorial Endowed Scholarship\* – \$1250 (\$2500 annual)**

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
