Au tman Co ege received subsequent awards through HEERF II and HEERF III in the amount of \$415,999 and \$376,138.00 respectively for a grand total of \$939,999.00 in the Institutional portion.

Method(s) Used to Determine Which Students Receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants

Aultman College will follow Department of Education rules to distribute HEERF grants directly to students and prioritize students with exceptional need. These grants reimburse students for expenses related to disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19. Funds go directly to students and are not used by the college to offset outstanding student balances. Maximum grant amounts are determined by the college based on available funds.
