Aultman Hospital Endowed Scholarship Fund – \$750 (1)

(Renewable, but must continue to meet scholarship requirements)

- Must have a minimum Aultman College GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must be a United States Citizen
- Must be a resident of Stark County
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA
- Preference will be given to minority students

- Must be an Aultman College nursing student

- Must be 24 years of age or less
- Must be a resident of Western Stark County
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

- Must be an Aultman College Nursing Student
- Must have a minimum high school or college GPA (whichever is most recent) of 2.5 or greater
- Must be enrolled a minimum of 6 credit hours or greater
- Must be in good academic standing
- Must demonstrate financial need according to the FAFSA

Class of 1959 Gifted Scholarship* – \$500 (1)

- Must be a non-traditional Aultman College nursing student
- Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 or greater

 - Currently working part-time, a parent, or primary caregiver of children or aging parents in the home
- Must have graduated from high school 10 years or more from time of this scholarship application
