OVERVIEW

The Aultman Health Foundation is a not-for-profit health care organization serving Stark and surrounding counties. The vertically integrated institution includes Aultman Hospital, the locally managed health-insurance provider AultCare and the Aultman College of Nursing and Health Sciences. With 682 beds, more than 575 active physicians and a staff of more than 5,000 employees, Aultman is Stark County's largest hospital and employer.

AultCare Corporation was established in 1985 as a means to provide high-quality, affordable health plans to local businesses. A joint effort between Stark Quality Care Physicians (local providers) and Aultman Health Foundation, AultCare is the largest hospital-based preferred provider organization in Ohio, with more than 500,000 enrollees from some 2,100 employer clients. Our health system's vertical-integration model aligns patients, providers, hospitals and the insurer – all to the benefit of the members' physical and financial health.

AultCare is accredited by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), a founding member of the Committee on Operating Rules for Information Exchange (CORE) and CORE II certified. CORE rules are a critical component for creating a more efficient health care system by helping providers get access to the information they need to make the best health care decisions. Our NCQA accreditation and CORE II certification exemplify our member-centric system.

PrimeTime Health Plan continues to be the most preferred Medicare Advantage health plan in Aultman's five-county market. Two out of three Medicare enrollees have chosen PrimeTime Health Plan to combine their Medicare benefits with Part D prescription drug coverage. With approximately 23,000 members, PrimeTime is the largest Medicare Advantage health plan in the area. PrimeTime continues to take an active role in ensuring local Medicare beneficiaries have the tools they need to make informed choices regarding their Medicare coverage.

Aultman College of Nursing and Health Sciences is a health-system-affiliated institution of higher learning committed to meeting the needs of nursing and allied health students by providing a coherent general and professional educational experience to prepare individuals for service and leadership roles.

The Aultman Foundation was established to improve the health of the community. The foundation provides grant funding to area nonprofit organizations that provide services focusing on health, education and human services – with special consideration for the underserved including the poor, elderly and children.

SATELLITE FACILITIES & AMBULATORY SERVICES

Aultman North offers immediate-care services for minor injuries and illnesses – seven days a week, 365 days a year. The unit is staffed with board-certified emergency room physicians. Aultman North also offers diagnostic testing, same-day surgery, physical and occupational therapy, cardiac rehabilitation services and a sleep center.

Aultman West offers immediate-care services for minor injuries and illnesses – seven days a week, 365 days a year. The unit is staffed with board-certified emergency room physicians. Aultman West also offers diagnostic testing, same-day surgery, short-stay inpatient surgery, physical and occupational therapy, cardiac rehabilitation services, a blood donor room and a sleep center.

Aultman Carrollton provides immediate-care services for minor injuries and illnesses, physical and occupational therapy and a fitness center that is open to the public. Various physician offices are also housed there.

Aultman Woodlawn features a 60-bed skilled nursing unit, a 30-bed rehabilitation unit and offices for Hospice/Palliative Care, Home Health Care and Aultman Grief Services. The facility was designed to provide a high level of service to subacute patients in a residential setting. Unique therapy areas reintroduce patients to homelike and community environments.

Aultman Dialysis Center of Canton provides outpatient dialysis services to patients with chronic renal failure.

Aultman Tusc offers outpatient therapy services including physical and occupational therapy, occupational rehabilitation, balance and vestibular rehabilitation, lymphedema therapy, limited fitness, sports medicine, stroke rehabilitation and aquatic therapy.

Aultman Center for Pain Management offers comprehensive services to help patients manage chronic pain.

Aultman Louisville offers both outpatient physical therapy and lab services.

Aultman Home Medical Supply provides high-quality home medical equipment. Staffed with experienced technicians and health care professionals, Aultman Home Medical Supply will manage the selection, delivery, setup and maintenance of home-care products.

AultWorks is certified by the Bureau of Workers' Compensation to treat work-related injuries and illnesses. AultWorks also provides executive health physicals, drug and alcohol screenings, a travel medicine program, workers' compensation risk management services and industrial safety consulting.

Aultman Physician Center provides outstanding care to underinsured and uninsured members of our community. Staffed by resident physicians and teaching attending physicians, the center offers medical services including primary care, obstetrics/gynecology and after-hours care for non-emergency situations.

Aultman Family Practice Hills & Dales and Aultman Family Practice Center of Waynesburg deliver high-quality health care to insured, underinsured and uninsured members of our community. Various physician offices are also housed there.

Aultman Weight Management offers medically supervised weight-loss programs to help people lose weight and improve their health.
