About the Program

The Medical Assisting Certificate Program uses a combination of classroom work, lab sessions and "on-the-job" training to educate students in the necessary front and back office skills to become medical assistants. Students will learn how to record patient information, schedule appointments, assist physicians with examinations, and give patient injections and medications. The program is accredited with AAMA for the CMA exam, AMT for the RMA exam, NHA for the CCMA exam, NCCT for the NCMA exam, and with AMCA for the CMAC exam.

Admission Requirements

First-time Freshman:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Demonstrate college readiness by meeting one of the following standards:
 - Minimum ACT composite score of 18
 - ☐ Minimum SAT combined score of 1030 (950 if prior to March 2016)
 - ACCUPLACER Next Generation score: minimum 250 in Reading (to schedule a testing appointment, please call 330-363-6347)

Transfer Student:

- Completion of six (6) college credits with a minimum grade of C (2.0)
- ACCUPLACER Next Generation score: minimum 250 in Reading (to schedule a testing appointment, please call 330-363-6347)

Application Process

The Medical Assisting Program admits students in fall semester. Interested students will need to submit a completed application online at *aultmancollege.edu* and submit official high school and college transcripts. Final acceptance is subject to completion of a two-step TB (tuberculosis) test.
