

## **URGENT NOTICE**

Feb. 10, 2022

Aultman College students:

According to our records, you are either vaccinated or have an approved exemption to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) vaccine mandate. Due to the co-mingling of vaccinated and exempt students, all students who enter Aultman College must comply with infection prevention strategies to help protect our campus.

The following enhanced infection prevention strategies have been implemented. Beginning **Feb. 14, 2022**, you must adhere to all the following guidelines:

### Exempt Students:

- You are required to screen for symptoms at the **Seventh Street** entry point prior to entering Aultman College (after hours – screen at the emergency room entry).
  - Due to CMS requiring screening, you will no longer have access to the Aultman College front doors.
- A surgical mask, at a minimum, must be worn at all times (one will be provided at the screening station).
- An Aultman screening sticker must be worn at all times, as random audits will be conducted.
- Continue to practice social distancing.
- Continue to practice good cleaning and hand hygiene.

### Vaccinated Students:

- Continue to self-screen and document on the Aultman portal if any symptoms are present.

- Clinical students will continue to self-screen and document as they currently do.
- Continue to practice social distancing.
- Continue to practice good cleaning and hand hygiene.

Even if Aultman College's infection prevention policies are changed or discontinued, you must continue to adhere to the above strategies. We reserve the right to make modifications at any time.
