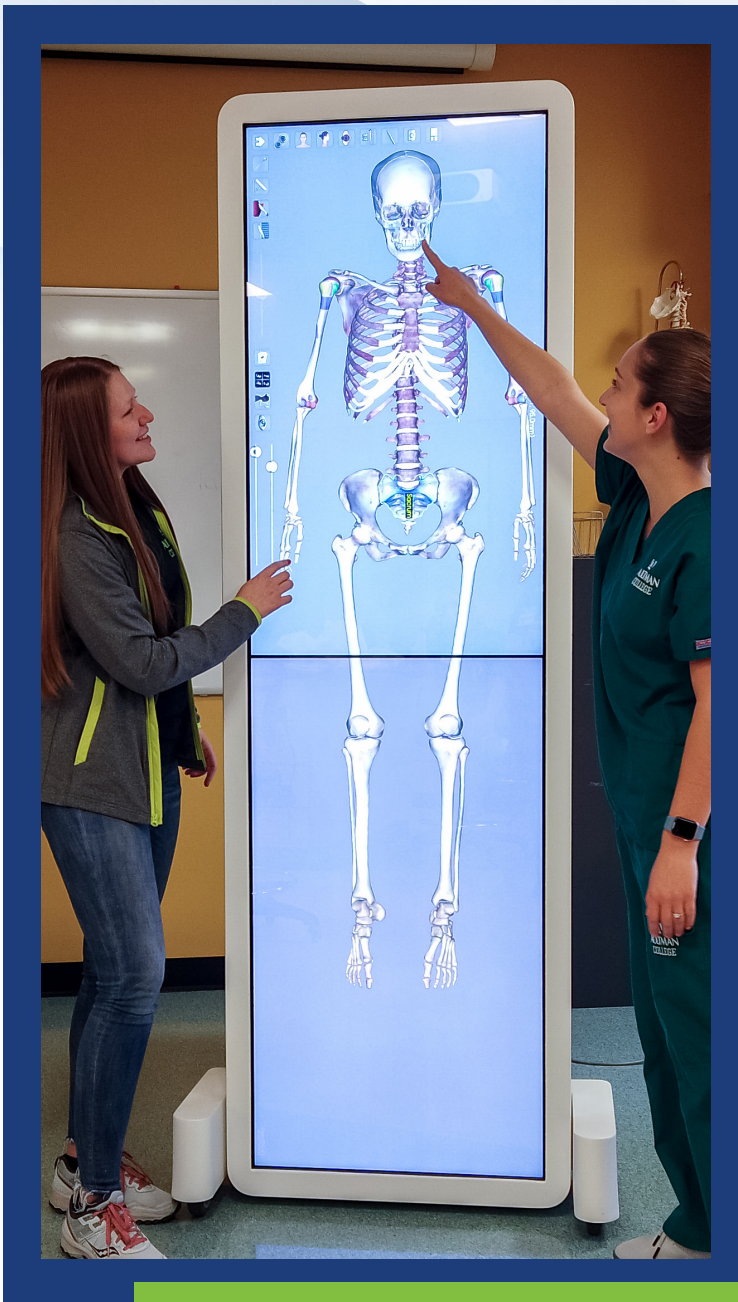

2020 - 2021 Academic Year Accomplishments

The 2020 - 2021 academic year was full of news. While responding to the pandemic, Aultman College continued to provide market relevant education. Accomplishments include:

Updated radiography simulation equipment thanks to the Fred Silk Foundation grant awarded in June 2020.

Recognized students' financial hardships intensified by the COVID-19 pandemic by not increasing tuition, awarding additional scholarships from the Spring Match Appeal, and dispersing HEERF dollars.

Exceeded enrollment goals and partnered with EAB to continue the growth trajectory.

Graduated first classes of Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) and Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) students. In addition, the first class of students completed the medical assisting program.

Awarded the Choose Ohio First grant by the Ohio Department of Higher Education, a competitive scholarship to support students enrolled in nursing, radiography, and medical assisting.

Executed the first year of a comprehensive five-year strategic plan, developed to support the new mission, vision and values.

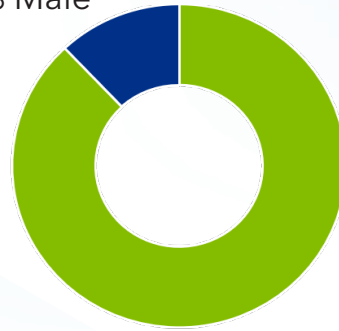

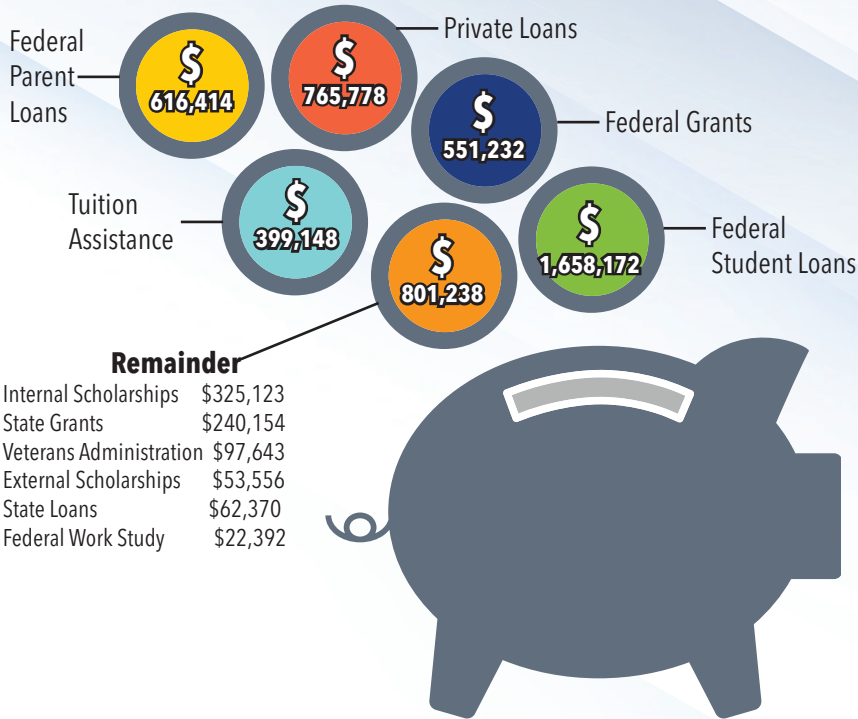

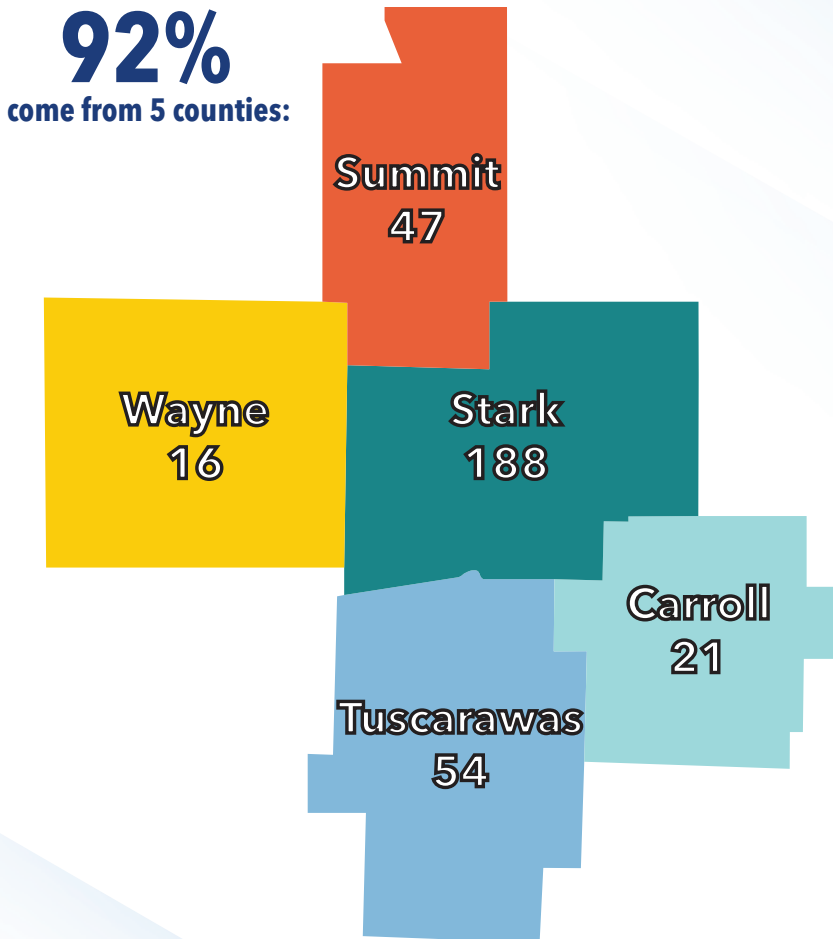
Student-To-Faculty Ratio

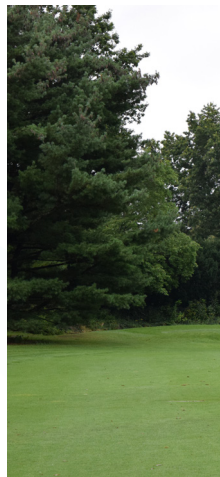
