About the Program

The bachelor of science in nursing (BSN) completion program at Aultman College is designed for registered nurses (RNs) who hold a diploma or associate degree. The degree can be completed in as few as five semesters and is 100 percent online for those with an associate degree in nursing.

Through a special articulation agreement, our students can save time and money on their way toward a master of science in nursing (MSN). BSN completion students have the ability to take three courses at Walsh University that will count toward both their Aultman College BSN and Walsh's MSN.

Admission Requirements

- Be a graduate of a regionally accredited nursing program with a certificate, diploma or associate degree in nursing
- Possess an active, unencumbered license as a registered nurse in Ohio or other select states (see program web page for details).

Application Process

The BSN Completion Program admits students in fall, spring and summer semesters.
